Congratulations! You have been approved for the NSCC Recruit Training beginning Wednesday 26 DEC 18 and ending on Thursday 03 JAN 19 at Red Horse AFB in Port Clinton, Ohio.

The Naval Sea Cadet Corps (NSCC) Recruit Training (RT) is the cadet's introduction to military routine and discipline and is the first step toward advancing in the Sea Cadet Program. Cadets spend nine days learning basic Navy subjects, elementary seamanship, basic damage control, and quarter's maintenance. Additionally, cadets participate in physical fitness training, drill basics, and following orders. A cadet must pass the RT physical fitness test (PRT) during training in order to receive credit for completing the RT. Successful completion of RT is required before the cadet is allowed to attend any other NSCC training offered anywhere (Advanced Training). There will be a final exam, so it is important to pay attention in class and utilize study hall time in evening. Instructors will be available during study hall to assist cadets with topics covered during day.

The Sea Bag list will be published on RTC section of training page. Do not bring things not on Sea Bag list.

All rules concerning Code of Conduct **MUST** be followed at all times. There will be no Sexual Harassment, Racism, Fraternization, Hazing, Bullying or Substance Abuse of any kind. Any of these infractions **MUST** be reported immediately to staff.

Graduation is Thursday 03 JAN 19 at 1000 hours.

Report to Red Horse AFB at 0900 on Wednesday 26 DEC 18. You must report in NWU uniforms with regulation grooming standards upon entry. You will have a Sea Bag check and service jacket review. Any medical allergies must be brought to attention of intake staff.

We look forward to your arrival and we will begin training on Day-1.
